Since 2011, ePosters, a modification of traditional paper-based posters, have gained popularity in medical education conferences. Unlike traditional posters, ePosters allow creators to focus on the learning process rather than solely reporting scientific outcomes. As a result, ePoster presentations have become an innovative active learning strategy and a component of student assessments in the Masters in Health Professions Education program. This session will discuss the utilization of ePosters as an assessment tool for online learning. We can expect to see the following outcomes:

- Compare and contrast ePosters and traditional posters
- Describe the effectiveness of ePosters for classroom assessments
- Identify strategies for incorporating ePosters for assessments in their own context.
